To participate, each provider must have a current license to practice medicine in the state of North Carolina and must not have been disciplined by the NC Medical Board in the past year.

Project Access roles and responsibilities:

- Recruit and retain volunteer physicians into the network
- Coordinate diagnostic and specialty referrals requests from PA participating physicians
- Administrate web-based technology for purpose of record-keeping and tracking physician commitments
- Manage relationships with physicians, hospitals and primary care clinics and community partners

Community Clinics roles and responsibilities:

- Screen uninsured enrollees for eligibility based on household income and Wake County residency
- Re-certify PA enrollees annually
- Serve as PA enrollee's Medical Home
- Refer PA enrollees for diagnostic and/or specialty care by scheduling appointments with participating providers
- Provide medical notes and test results to specialty providers prior to enrollee appointment

Hospital, Anesthesiology and Diagnostic Services roles and responsibilities:

- Provide diagnostic services (blood work, x-rays, MRIs, CT scans, ultrasound, cardiac testing, pulmonary function testing and nerve conduction studies).
- Provide hospital based services, as appropriate.
- Provide anesthesiology services, as appropriate.

Participating Provider roles and responsibilities:

- Accept PA enrollees as indicated on the Donated Care Pledge form on the reverse side.
- Provide free medical services for PA enrolled enrollees referred for care.
- Accept new referrals and examine and treat enrolled PA enrollees who have completed eligibility screening and carry a current PA identification card.
- Refer uninsured enrollees into PA where enrollment coordinators will determine eligibility and help them obtain free care from doctors in other specialties and free diagnostic procedures.
- Send/fax a claim for the actual charges (to tally donated services) to the PA office.
- Maintain current medical license in NC with no current disciplinary actions on file.
- Treat PA enrolled enrollees the same as all other enrollees by rendering all services normally and routinely given, including referring for laboratory and radiology testing through one of the three Wake County hospitals.
- Provide medical notes to the PA enrollment clinic from where the enrollee was referred.
- Send/fax a claim for the actual charges (to tally donated services) to the PA office.
